Differentiators Data completed a survey of 500 North Carolinians on the issue of abortion for Susan B. Anthony Pro-Life America and others in January of 2023.

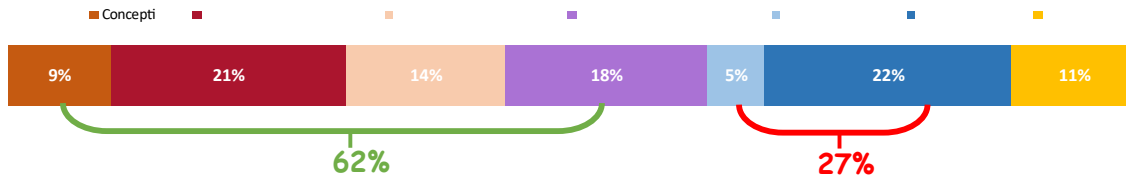
You asked: What does your January survey of North Carolina voters' thoughts on abortion tell us about their opinions on a bill that limits abortions to the first trimester of pregnancy except in instances of rape, incest or to protect the life of the mother?

The survey showed 62% of all voters support laws that would limit abortions with exceptions for rape, incest or to protect the life of the mother in North Carolina to the first trimester of pregnancy or earlier. Majorities of Republicans, Unaffiliateds, men, women, white and black voters agree with this position. The only group of voters that opposes these limitations on abortion are registered Democrats.

Q25: Which type of abortion law would you prefer the NC legislature adopt?



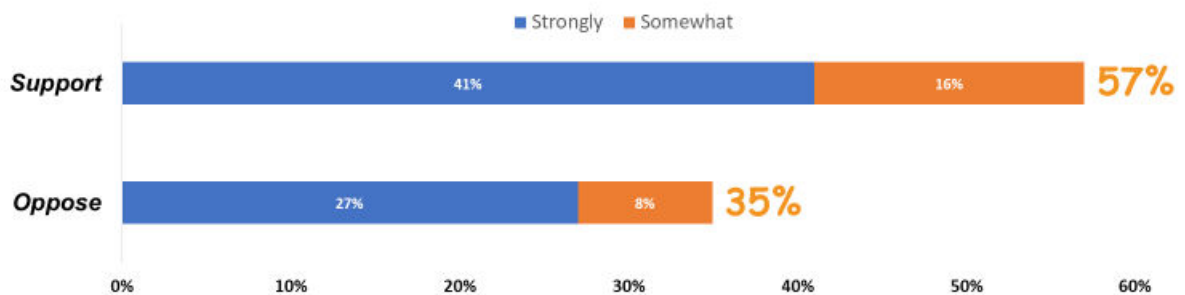

The current limitations on abortion in North Carolina law all have the support of a majority of voters and this proposed regulation of abortion earns similar or higher levels of support than the existing limitations. A limitation on abortion after the first trimester of pregnancy is less popular than requiring parental consent for minors to have abortions but is arguably more popular than 72-hour waiting period and ultrasound requirements.



72-Hour Waiting Period

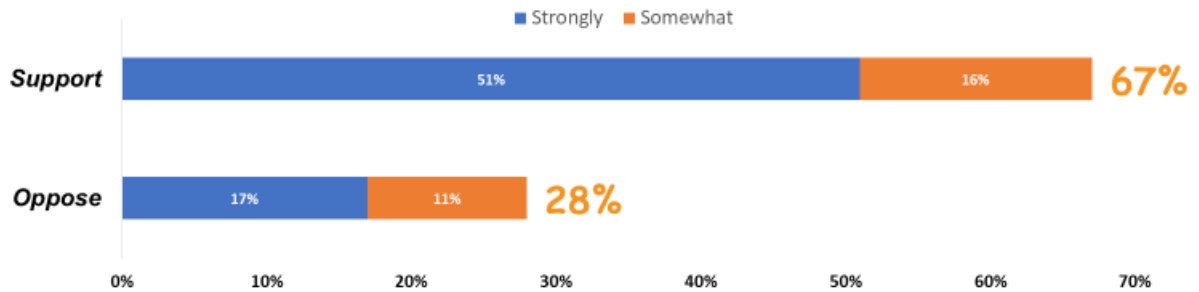
Q33: Do you support or oppose... the North Carolina law requiring a 72-hour waiting period before a person can have an abortion?

Parental Consent

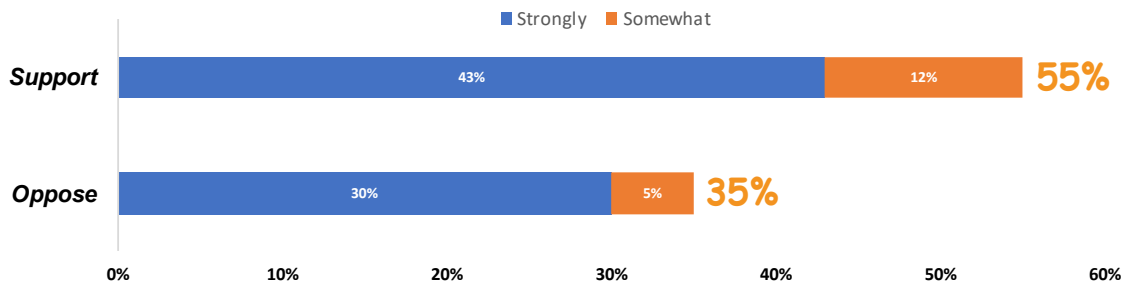
Q34: Do you support or oppose... the North Carolina law requiring parental consent in order for a minor to have an abortion?
